Andrea Bagnarol: could you please share the link for the website again?

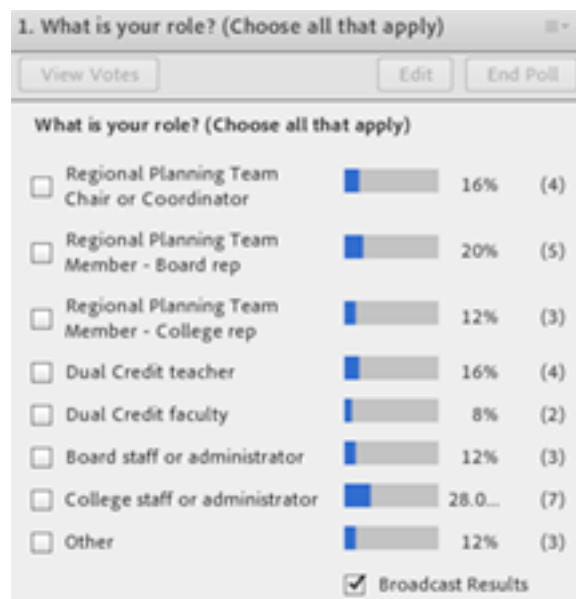
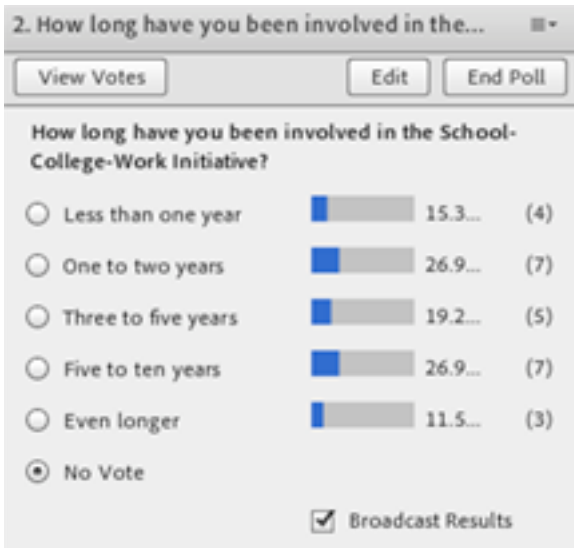
